Costumes -

Will be going home in April. All fees/tuition must be current.

Please look inside your costume bag right away. Your costume will have instructions on hair, shoes, makeup, and other important details. You may have to make minor adjustments to shoulder straps, pant hems or tighten up some waistbands. We work hard to try and get students the best fit. Sometimes, they need adjustments. Please be sure your dancer is prepared and looking their best!

Tights -

You will receive a Tight Voucher with your costumes. You are responsible for coming into the studio and picking out your tights! You must bring the voucher with you. These tights are included with the cost of your costume. It is best if you pick out your tight size. Each dancer will receive ONE pair of tights (per color/style), NOT per costume.

Tickets -

Dancers/Performers DO NOT need tickets. You can purchase tickets right from your parent portal. There are three seating options ranging in price from \$18-\$25 for adults and \$10-\$15 for children under 10. Currently enrolled dancers who want to see one of the other shows can purchase a ticket for \$5.00 (ask the front desk for a promo code).

If you have a dancer in all four shows, you are eligible for Two (2) free tickets. The requirements are to buy tickets to at least two shows and volunteer to work backstage at at least one show. Once you have purchased your tickets and signed up for volunteering, you can email the studio for a promo code to get your two free tickets.

All ticket sales are FINAL.

Programs -

In an effort to be more eco-friendly and reduce costs, we will be utilizing digital programs for our event. If your dancer is in more than one show, they may stay at the high school in between shows. MCDA staff will NOT monitor or be responsible for dancers who are left in between shows. This is the staff's break and prep time for the next show. Dancers must be supervised by an adult at all times.

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
